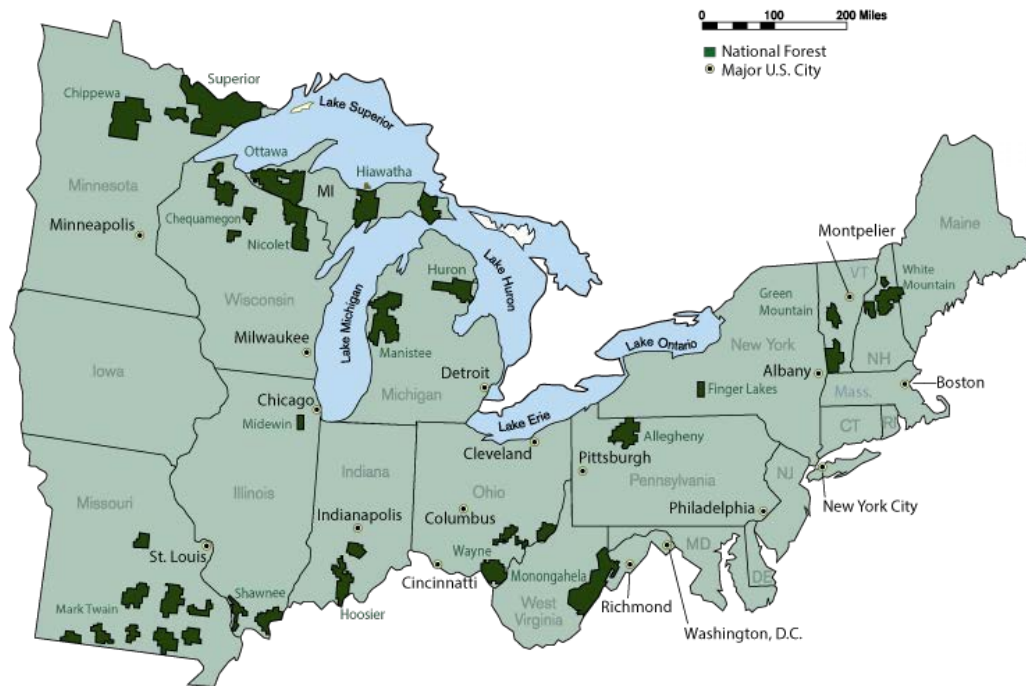


# USDA Forest Service

## Eastern Region (Region 9) Resource Assistants Program



The USDA Forest Service Eastern Region, in partnership with the Greening Youth Foundation, invites students and recent graduates to apply to 20 positions in the Region 9 Resource Assistants Program. Participants will have the opportunity to gain mentorship and experience while developing the tools and skills necessary for careers in land management agencies.

### Basic Eligibility Requirements:

- At least 18 years old and working on a degree
- US citizen or legal resident
- Have a strong interest, or relevant experience, in natural resources, public service, and connecting people to public lands

### Program Objectives:

- Encourage diverse youth to study and pursue careers in conservation
- Increase relevance, diversity, and inclusion in the USDA Forest Service workplace

### Opportunities will include:

- Natural and Cultural Resource Management
- Research and Development
- Data Collection and Analysis
- Communication and Public Affairs

### Participants will:

- Begin work in August, and continue full-time for a year
- Be compensated at a rate of \$12/hour
- Receive a two-year hiring authority at the completion of the program
